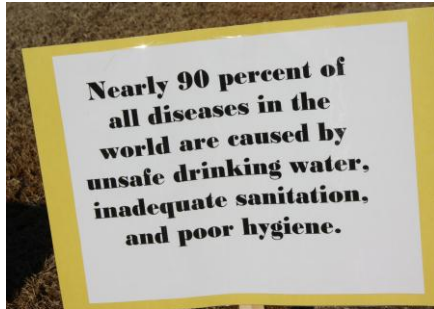


# Where will you make a difference?

## Me Volunteer?

### Yes, You.

Did you know that more teens volunteer than work? Everybody can volunteer somewhere and really make an impact. LCA's community service program, IMPACT can help connect you with volunteer opportunities and recognize those of you who go above and beyond .

The purpose of the program is to develop a lifestyle of service by providing opportunities for leadership outside of academics and athletics. It also allows your spiritual gifts and talents to be used to impact our community for Christ. Besides all of that, colleges and employers love to see volunteer service hours on applications.

You may select almost any area of service (refer to guidelines listed). Students with 20 hours or more of community service will be recognized at the end of the school year. Students completing 30 or more hours are eligible for membership in the honorary club, *Emerio*.

### Guidelines for completing 20 hours for the school year:

- Any community service work completed June 2010 until May 14, 2011 will count for the 2010-2011 school year.
- Hours must be recorded in your student portfolio.
- Hours must be volunteer hours with no form of payment or credit.
- When in doubt, ask your advisor, Mrs. Hawkins or Mrs. Johnson.
- Hours for mission trips will be 1/3<sup>rd</sup> of the actual trip length unless the actual work time is greater.
- Hours completed with your church group can count as IMPACT hours.
- An adult supervisor is required to sign-off on your volunteer work
