Varsity Baseball

The Loganville Christian Academy Lions varsity baseball team lost the first two games of their "best two out of three" series with the #1 ranked Tattnell Square Academy Trojans in the quarterfinals of the GISA AAA playoffs this past weekend in Macon.

In game one, on May 11, Tattnell out hit LCA to win by a score of 13-3. Two of the Lions' runs were scored thanks to timely hitting by Nic Snowden, who doubled in the second inning and singled in the fifth inning. Craig Roe also picked up two hits, and Tyler Browning doubled to lead the offensive attack for the Lions.

In game two on Saturday, May 12, the Lions lost by a score of 8-7 in nine innings. Marshall Dreyer racked up four RBIs on two hits for LCA. He hit a grand slam to give the Lions a one run lead in the fourth inning and singled in the seventh inning. Dreyer's breaking ball was dominant, allowing him to keep the Trojans' bats in check for eight innings. Tyler Browning picked up a double and a single, and Hunter Cook contributed a two-run double for the Lions. In the third inning, LCA scored three runs on an RBI single by Matt Lype and a two-run double by Hunter Cook. After a quick strike from Tattnell, LCA responded with four runs in the fourth on Dreyer's grand slam. Tattnell loaded the bases in the top of the ninth inning on a single and two fielding errors. The go ahead run crossed the plate on a hit batsman. The Lions' defense rose to the occasion to get out of the inning with two fielders choice force outs at the plate and a fly out to left field. The Lions went three up, three down in the bottom of the ninth inning to end their season.

"I am so proud of the way that our young team rose to the challenge this year, after losing seven seniors from last years' team and three more starters this year. It was also great to see our two seniors, Hunter Cook and Marshall Dreyer, play so well to end their high school careers; we're going miss them," noted LCA head baseball coach, Vince Kirkland.

The Lions finished the season with an 11-10-1 overall record, and a 3-3-0 record in GISA Region 1-AAA.
